Terms and Conditions

- 1. The name of the award will be "IMSA-Dr. Karmegam Dushyanthan Award" for Best Doctoral Thesis in the field of Livestock Products Technology (LPT) or Meat Science and Technology.
- The award shall be sponsored from the interest accrued from the fixed deposit of Rs. 50,000/- contributed by Dr. K. Dushyanthan, Professor (Retd), Madras Veterinary College, Chennai. The award will be conferred on selected candidates during the annual/biannual conference of the association.
- 3. The award will be conferred during the annual IMSA Conference. Every year one Ph.D Thesis will be awarded. In case if the event is held after 2 years, two awards will be given. The individual award will consist of a citation and a memento bearing the IMSA logo.

4. **Objectives of the Award**

To recognize the outstanding original research done by Doctoral degree students in the area of Livestock Products Technology (LPT) or Meat Science and Technology.

5. Eligibility

- 5.1 For the award of 2023, the Ph.D thesis submitted after the previous IMSACON XI (December, 2022) till November, 2023 and for the award of 2024, the Ph.D thesis submitted from December 2023 till the last date of application of the current year award (July 2024) will be considered, provided the degree should be awarded before the last date of application for the award.
- 5.2 The thesis should be a part of the Doctoral programme that leads to Ph.D degree in Livestock Products Technology/Meat Science and Technology/ any other allied subjects with specialization in meat science.

5.3 Applicant must be a life member of Indian Meat Science Association (IMSA).

6. **Administration of the Award**

There shall be a Judging Committee consisting of 2-3 expert members appointed by the President, IMSA. The judging committee will shortlist thesis (depending on the number of applications) for each year and recommend to EC of IMSA. After approval from President, IMSA the shortlisted candidates will be informed.

7. Evaluation Criteria

The thesis will be evaluated on the basis of potential of the thesis work (basic/applied) for advancing the existing knowledge/practical utility/novelty/quality and clarity of presentation.

8. **Procedure**

Applications for the award made in the prescribed application proforma may be downloaded from the IMSA web site (<u>www.imsa.org.in</u>). The duly filled application be accepted on or before **31**st **July 2024.** Soft copy of the duly filled application along with the soft copy of the thesis and all other documents (X, XII, Under-graduation, Master and Doctoral degree certificates; Reference letter from the Advisor and Forwarding letter from the Department Head/ Dean of the college where last studied or forwarding letter from the employer if working; Reprints of published papers etc.) may be sent to **Secretary, IMSA at <u>imsanrem@gmail.com</u>.**

9. **Presentation**

The presentation of award will be made during the IMSA meeting/conference. The shortlisted candidates will make a presentation of about 10-15 min. on salient achievements of his/her work to the audience during IMSA National seminar. It is compulsory for the shortlisted candidates to be present during the seminar and must make the presentation personally. Without presentation, the candidate will not be considered for the award. The judging committee consisting of 2-3 experts will evaluate (score) the presentation for Best Thesis and recommend to EC of IMSA. Initial thesis evaluation score (80%) and presentation score (20%) will be totaled and one Best Thesis will be selected for each year award. After approval from President, IMSA the selected candidate will be given the award on the last day of the National Seminar during IMSA General Body Meeting. No TA/DA will be provided to applicants.
